- Signature Event managers – manage one or two Signature Event(s) from start to finish

- Facebook – manage & update FB page
- Webmaster – manage & update website
- Communications Director – club emails, and articles to the Marque
- Sponsorship/Partnership Manager – find and manage sponsors
- Tech Session manager – organize and lead tech sessions (Zoom and in-person)
- Regalia Manager – manage the regalia catalog, supplier, orders, payments
- Awards Committee chair – handle award nominations, presentation.
- Nominating Committee chair – create nominee list for leader positions. Manage elections.
- Membership Manager – track membership, welcome new members, work with Treasurer to monitor membership subscriptions.
- Events Director – develop and track event schedule. Make sure each event has a leader, that events have proper resources, work with webmaster and FaceBook director to properly publicize event.
- Sunshine Chair: send cards, flowers, etc. to members in hospital or recovering at home.
