Cameron Ferguson, President, opened the meeting at 9:05AM:

- **Welcome**
 - Sign-up sheet was passed around
- **Business Report:**
 - **Finance:** Available cash on Oct 15, 2025 is ~\$16,300
 - CCBCC is financially very healthy.
 - Reiterated the club's fiscal policy that Operating Expenses are covered by Member's Dues, and...
 - Events pretty much cover their expenses. However, some Club funds (\$100-\$300) might be used to cover some event expenses as the Club tries to keep member charges affordable even when venues are raising prices.
 - **Membership Statistics:**
 - Total Members 226
 - **Membership Changes (since January 1):**
 - New Members in 2025: 34
 - Members who left: (23) (15 of whom were Year-End Non Renewals)
 - Net Increase 11
 - Overall, the club is growing.
- **2025 in Review**
 - 2025 was a great year for cruises, car shows, tech sessions.

 - Rescued seven (7) cars from long term storage
 - Helped members with specific repairs
 - Philanthropy & FundRaisers:
 - Freezin' Fun Run
 - 23 cars / 35 attendees
 - \$2400+ raised.
 - Rallye Cape Cod
 - Raised \$1150. Club added \$350 = \$1,500
 - Matching donation of \$1500 was confirmed for a total of \$3,000
 - Each organization (ARL, Family Pantry, Cape Tech Foundation) received \$1,000.

- Habitat: British Car Clubs – Building Bright Futures (BCC-BBF):
 - CCBCC raised \$2265 for Habitat Cape Cod
 - BCC-BBF involved 5 clubs (FL,PA, NJ, NY, MA): raised \$11,500+
 - Donations made to CC Tech Schools:
 - \$1,000 to both CC Tech Schools = \$2,000
 - **TOTAL from CCBCC: \$9,665**

- Special Topic: **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS**
 - Element Fire Extinguisher -
 - Doesn't need recharging
 - Doesn't leave a mess
 - Is quite small, 10.75" x 1.2", about the size of a flare cartridge
 - Weighs ½ a pound
 - Can be easily stored so handy when you need it.
 - Super simple to operate
 - Effective against ALL the major fire classes
 - Lasts about 50 secs. which is 5X normal extinguishers
 - Costs \$89. Is currently selling at upto 25% discount for multiple unit purchases.
