WINTER STORAGE

As you put your car away for the winter, here are some tips/things to think about and do:

- Clean the car.
- Interior Upholstery
 - o Clean the upholstery. If vinyl, treat with 303 Protectant (available from West Marine).
 - Treat the Shift knob boot with 303 Protectant.
- Gas tank
 - o Fill it.
 - o Additives/Fuel Stabilizer: some use, others don't. Suggest Stabil
 - o Ethanol will soak up any liquid water.
- Battery:
 - Disconnect cables at least the positive, or both cables
 - o Don't need to remove, but if you do, store in a cool & dry place.
 - o Attach trickle charger- a member likes this charger, https://a.co/d/dfod9JE
 - This link is US version. (Some chargers are ok for a few weeks of storage but eventually the battery fails. These are good for long term storage.)
- Coolant
 - o Top coolant up with water/anti-freeze mixture.
 - Check for temperature rating. Make sure coolant can withstand the worst temperatures that you would expect.
- Engine Oil
 - Change oil and filter BEFORE storing.
 - o Run engine to operating temperature before storing.
- Top
 - Put the top up so it stays stretched out.
 - o If you can remove top, then store in warm area to keep it pliable
 - o If Top is Vinyl, trerat it with 303 Protectant as it prevents fading & cracking (keeps vinyl flexible) and repels dust and dirt. 303 is available at West Marine
- Tires:
 - o pump the tires up maybe a few psi (+4psi) over normal.
 - A member runs normally at 23 so goes to 26/27.
 - Lifting the car: some do, some don't, depends on whether you hope to use the car.
 Usually not necessary unless you're not going to use the car for a very long period.
 - Modern tires do not develop permanent flat spots.
- Car Covers
 - Some do, some don't.
 - Remove all dust on car before installing the cover.
 - Make sure cover material is compatible with your paint job.

- Tail Pipe:
 - Plug to stop dampness and mice. Use foam plug, bronze wool, steel wool. Bronze wool available at West Marine. (Mice don't like steel wool as it hurts their skin).
 - Will usually get blown out, but you may want to put a tag on steering wheel as a reminder to remove before starting.
- Rodent prevention in storage area.
 - No food in storage area
 - No bird food keep the mice out of the storage area.
 - o Moth balls in car: some do, some don't. Smell can be a problem.
 - Dryer sheets in car: some do, some don't.
 - Fresh Cab Rodent Repellent- https://a.co/d/0q2QEzf
 - Ultrasonic pest repeller- https://a.co/d/4sY2a3L.
- Should you exercise the car during the shut down period ??
 - o You can if you want to, but.....
 - Make sure you get up to running temperature.
 - o 10 minute running will cause more harm than good. Recommend 30 minutes.
 - Obviously, do not take on snow, wet roads, salty roads.
